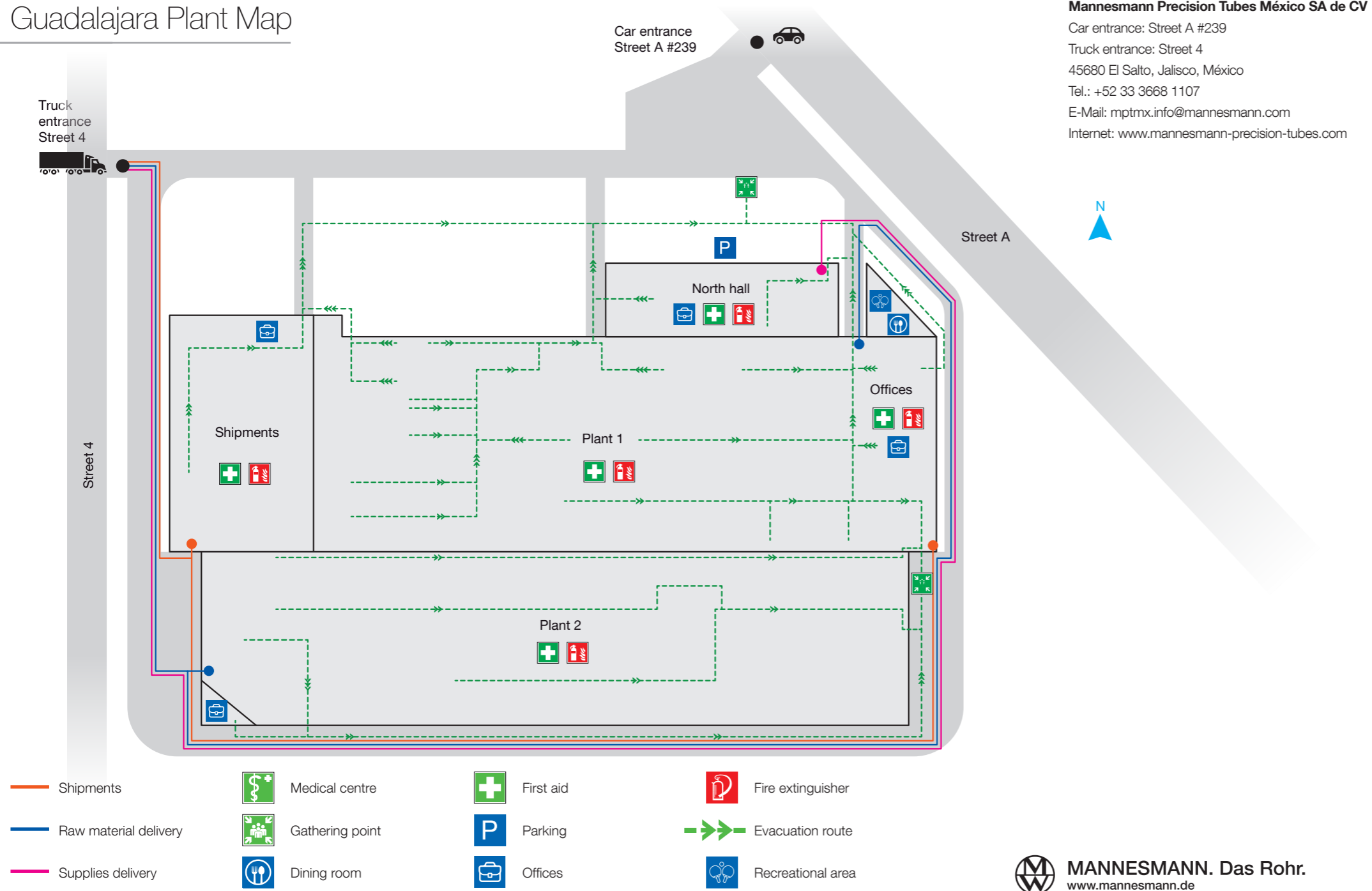


# Guadalajara Plant Map

Welcome to Mannesmann Precision Tubes Mexico. The health and safety of our employees, contractors, visitors and all external personnel is our top priority. Here are our main basic safety rules that will make your visit more productive and safe.

## General information and rules of conduct



The maximum speed for driving a vehicle is 10 km/h (6 mph).



When parking a vehicle it is necessary to park in reverse. Respect reserved parking spaces.



Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the facilities.



It is forbidden to enter the facilities under the influence of alcohol or drugs.



The use of basic personal protective equipment in the production area (helmet, glasses, earplugs and safety boots) is mandatory.



Never touch the pipes or moving parts of a machine. It is mandatory to use a locking, padlocking and tagging system to enter the equipment.



It is forbidden to wear loose clothing that could cause entrapment in the machines.



It is forbidden to take photos and videos without authorization.



Be careful with slippery surfaces. slippery surfaces. Do not enter areas that are areas that are delimited.



Access to unauthorized areas is prohibited.



People with pacemakers will not be allowed to enter or approach areas with this symbol.



Pay attention to suspended loads. It is forbidden to pass under them.



Do not cross forklift crossing areas. Before crossing, make sure the driver has seen you and allows you to pass. Never pass behind a forklift in reverse.



There is a closed-circuit television system inside and outside the company's facilities.



You can identify firefighting brigadiers by their red helmets.



In case of emergency, you can receive first aid in the nursing area 24 hours a day.



If the evacuation alarms sound, go to the nearest assembly point and wait for the instructions of the corresponding brigades.



Respect emergency equipment. Do not obstruct them and if they are used in a situation, report to EHS personnel after the event is over.
